Stories We Live By: Claudia Cole In 2011, Claudia Cole had just moved to Baltimore and was actively looking for work. After some time not being hired, a relative told her to contact MND. At first, Claudia was skeptical about the idea of an organization that helps individuals with career counseling and job placement at no cost. However, she found the interview and resume services very useful. After MND, she felt "definitely ready" to enter the workforce.
